On 6 February, 2007 the Convention was opened for signature in Paris. We were pleased to see that Greece was one of the countries to sign on October 1st, 2008. So far 81 countries have signed the Convention and 10 countries have ratified.

We welcome the positive attitude of the Greek government towards the Convention. However, we notice the lapse of more than two years since its signature with no further developments. Its paramount importance for Greece can hardly be overstated. Greece and Cyprus have long suffered from this practice with many disappearances of Greek and Cypriot citizens still being unresolved.

We would therefore urge you to promote the preparation of a ratifying law to the National Parliament as a top priority of your Ministry. The Convention will enter into force after 20 ratifications. By taking action without hesitation, Greece would be distinguished among the first countries to ratify the Convention and would therefore be instrumental to its entry into force.
